## PEMBROKESHIRE CONFERENCE 2024

*Monday 15th July to Friday 19th July*

### STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The BAA Annual Conference 2024 will explore and debate the artistic, architectural and archaeological wealth of Pembrokeshire, Wales. This will be the first time in its 180 year-history that the British Archaeological Association has visited this significant county. The conference will be based at Pembrokeshire College, in the once important medieval town of Haverfordwest. Lectures will include papers on a variety of subjects ranging from Roman & Early Medieval Pembrokeshire, Norman monasticism, archaeology, architecture and sculpture of St Davids Cathedral, 14th century bishops' palaces, local parish churches & castles, 16th and 18th century manor houses, screens, manuscripts, wall paintings and bishops' croziers at St Davids Cathedral.

Site visits will include a walking tour of Haverfordwest exploring the major remaining medieval sites. There will be three coach excursions (one full & two half-days) outside Haverfordwest. These will encompass St Davids (cathedral, cathedral close and bishop's palace) Picton Castle, Carew Castle, Tenby (Tour of medieval walled town with an 18th century seaside resort, including St Mary's Church and a 15th century Merchants House) Manorbier Castle, Lamphey, Bishop's Palace, Pembroke Castle & Monkton Priory.

Applications are invited for student scholarships. The conference will run from lunchtime on Monday 15th July to lunchtime on Friday 19th July, 2024. Scholarships will only be awarded to those who can attend the conference in its entirety. The scholarship covers lectures and site visits, accommodation for four nights, and all included meals, refreshments and receptions.

The deadline for applications is **20th April, 2024**. Applicants will be notified by 3rd May, 2024. Please note that it is the responsibility of the applicant to either send the academic reference with the application or to make sure their nominated referee sends it in. The BAA will not chase for references.

Scholarships are given to those studying at postgraduate level and those who have been awarded research degrees in these areas within the last two years. The scholarships are funded by the generosity of BAA members and the number awarded varies according to the funds available. Successful applicants are expected to join the BAA if not already members. The maximum number of scholarships to attend a BAA summer conference to any one individual is two.
